



## Special AGM Outcome -Changes to your Clubrooms

As all members were aware, a special AGM was held in October to consider the option of converting the Clubrooms to the Eastern Community Sports (ESCR) Hub.

The objective of this change was to ensure our Club is sustainable for generations to come, but it also means the Clubrooms will be used more often by the ESCR member Clubs that has a collective membership exceeding 1500 members.

Despite what was a potentially the most significant decision for our Club to make regarding it's future, we had a pretty average turnout which included only one current player. A vote was conducted at the end of the meeting which UNANIMOUSLY supported the conversion of the Clubrooms to the Hub.

Since that meeting, I am pleased to advise that I have been successful in securing a \$200,000 grant which will go a long way towards making this project a reality. We still have a shortfall of around \$100,000 to find but I am confident we can do that.

The grant will go towards making the following changes to the Clubrooms -

- (a) Replace the roof
- (b) Relocate the kitchen upstairs into the meeting room
- (c) Refit the old downstairs lounge to a community space, plus add in two more changing rooms
- (d) Re-branding the Club from NBRFC to the ECSR Hub
- (e) A new clubrooms access system

We have a good deal of work to do over the coming months, but all members will be kept up-to-date with progress. We will be looking to utilise Club tradesmen to make these changes as cost effective as


## **ECSR Secure Funding!**

The ESCR Board received some great news over the last 10 days with the granting of a \$400,000 Lotteries grant towards the court and canopy project over the old tennis courts located in Rawhiti Domain.

This grant means we have 95% of the \$1.2million funding to complete this project, and we are now working through the consent process with CCC to start construction ASAP.

This will be a fantastic community facility for the Eastern Suburbs, and from a rugby perspective, will potentially be able to be used for training purposes when the grounds get too wet in the heart of the winter.
