

TRANSITION TO ECSR HUB UNDERWAY!

As communicated in recent newsletters, the Rugby Clubrooms will be transitioning over the coming weeks and months to become the Eastern Community Sports and Recreation Hub (ESCR).

As you will appreciate, this building is aging and needs a good deal of money spent on it. I have been fortunate to be able to secure around \$450,000 in funding which will allow this transition to take place. What is important to understand is that this money would not have been approved if we were to remain a stand-alone rugby club. This money has been approved on the basis that we will have a combined membership exceeding 1500 members across the various sporting and community groups that will call this building their home base.

So here is a summary of the things that have either happened, or will be happening over the coming weeks -

- (a) A minor repair to a wall on the eastern side of the Club has just been completed
- (b) The old hot water system in the alleyway downstairs, and the old gas system upstairs have been removed to create some space
- (c) The old chiller downstairs that is used for alcohol storage will be removed, and a new storage space has been constructed upstairs to the right of the bar
- (d) A new commercial kitchen will replace the old kitchen downstairs commencing mid-June 2019
- (e) The roof on the building will be fully replaced by Wayman Roofing (Marcel Cummings-Toone) starting in early June
- (f) A new card access system will be installed on the front door, the door leading into the indoor court, and the back door leading into the old lounge
- (g) The building will be painted internally and externally
- (h) Rugby memorabilia will be removed from the main lounge, and a new memorabilia space for all Clubs will be created in the meeting room
- (i) The old downstairs lounge will be refitted into a community/recreational space
- (j) An additional stairway will be added to the northern side of the building and a significant fire alarm upgrade will be done across the entire building

Through this process, we need to be aware that some changes will be made that may night entirely suit, or be different to what we have experienced in the past, but they are being done for the greater benefit of all users.

Exciting times ahead and done with the best intentions of securing our Club future.
